## **Musical Notes**

On Sunday, August 9, the choir will sing “Sanctus” from a mass setting written by Patrick Poole, uncle of Harvey Poole. Dr. Poole, who died in 1989, received his Bachelor of Music in voice from the University of Tulsa, his Masters from Pittsburg State University, and his Ph.D. from the University of Southern California. He taught music at the University of California, Fresno and at Farleigh Dickenson University. The Sanctus the choir will be singing has been performed in St. Paul’s Cathedral in Oklahoma City, Grace Cathedral in Topeka, St. James Cathedral in Fresno, and possibly in the National Cathedral in Washington, D.C. We are grateful to Harvey for providing this wonderful manuscript for our use.

Beginning on Sunday, August 23, there will be a 15 minute prelude once a month prior to the 10:30 service. This will include choral music, instrumental music and organ music. This prelude will usually be on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Sunday of each month, with the exception of this first prelude. With the anticipated large congregation expected this month on the 23<sup>rd</sup> with the arrival of our new priest-in-charge, the St. Anne Prelude and Fugue of Bach will played and is approximately 15 minutes long.
