ANNUAL FALL FESTIVAL immediately following the 10:30 service.

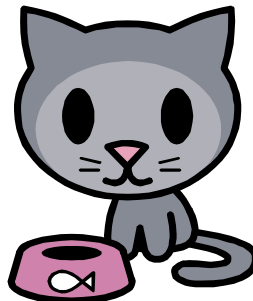
